

## Remote assessment guidance

We expect only the following visits to occur from now until the study end date of 31/05/2022:

- Cases diagnosed < 3 years Visit 10 (72 months)
- Cases diagnosed < 3 years Visit 11 (90 months)
- Relatives Visit 2 (36 months)

There are several ways sites can implement study visits under restrictions imposed by COVID-19. Where safe and appropriate, and if there is sufficient local resource, assessments can be performed:

- in-person at clinic e.g., if a participant is already attending clinic for another reason
- in-person at home, if safe and practical for both participant and assessor
- remotely via teleconference/video link/Zoom/Skype
- remotely via telephone

Where clinical assessments are performed remotely, this should be recorded in a file note locally and as a Memo on the relevant form on the study database. The coordinating centre understands that not all sites will be equipped to perform certain clinical assessments remotely, depending on resource and experience of research staff. As such, the following guidance for remote visits is offered to help sites collect as much data as possible:

Assessment	Note
Medication	No impact, collect data as normal
Blood pressure, pulse, weight (BPW)	If participant is able to report their own blood pressure and weight, this can be recorded
Diagnostic features	Can be performed by review of medical record supplemented with telephone and/or video assessments
UPDRS Clinician	Parts 1 and 4 (including Hoehn and Yahr, Schwab and England) can be performed by telephone and/or video assessments. Part 3 can be performed by video assessment in some cases if the participant has tablet or PC--but not if the participant only has a mobile phone. If conducting Part 3 is possible, omit the rigidity and pull test balance assessments but otherwise include as many other items as possible (e.g. omit gait/turning if difficult).
L-Dopa Challenge	Cannot be performed remotely, omit
MoCA	Post copies of Questions 1-4 (drawing and naming animals) to participant and complete together during assessment. Participant should return this page with other patient questionnaires. No impact on verbal components, collect as normal.
Blood tests	Cannot be performed remotely.
Past medical history	No impact, collect data as normal
Scans	No impact, collect data as normal
Tissue Bank	(Relatives only) Reminder of Tissue bank donation scheme can be given remotely; relevant documents can be posted along with patient questionnaires

There is no impact on the following patient questionnaires that should be completed at home and returned to study sites by post. The coordinating centre will provide franked envelopes for sites to forward to participants with their questionnaires.
